in the vineyard

Wine-growing Area: Klein River Ward, Western Cape, South Africa

in the cellar

All grapes were hand picked and sorted before being crushed directly in to the tanks where skin contact is allowed for 4 hours. 6 - 15 % of each variety were extracted and inoculate with pure yeast cultures to optimize fermentation at around 16° C. The wine was allowed to naturally clarify under gravity prior to filtering and bottling.
